

- 1) Fill out the header – call sign and station type. Station type is **critical** for an accurate score.
- 2) Fill out the footer – Please take note of the ___ of ___ fields; this helps us keep track of your log sheets and to be sure we have all of them!
- 3) Columns:
 - 1) **No.** - Please start with the number “1” and number upwards.
 - 2) **Call Sign** – Call sign of the station you are working
 - 3) **Time** – is the local time (24 hour clock is appreciated, but not required; **no need** for UTC)
 - 4) **Freq.** - Frequency as indicated at your rig.
 - 5) **Power** – Power as indicated at your rig. Class (**QRP or Full**; see contest rules for definitions) is fine.
 - 6) **Town 1** – is the Town where your station is currently located
 - 7) **Town 2** – is the Town where the station you are currently working is located
- 4) Neatness counts. If we can't read your sheet, we can't score you.
- 5) Contest Date and Time is May 9th, 2020 from Noon to 3:00 PM, local time
- 6) To be scored logs must be received by June 18th, 2020.
- 7) Everyone who submits a log will receive a certificate.
- 8) Top five scores will be posted on the KLARA website.
